### Quail Egg

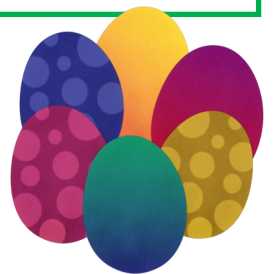
Well we lost another one.. Belinda is off on her way to a new job and can no longer do Quail Eggs. If you would like to help out we would love to have you join us.

Postale Tissue Wrap...possibilities in a box!

If you haven't played with the new Postale Tissue Wrap, you are missing out! I am not sure what it is made of, however, the opaque tissue is thin yet strong, it can be crinkled yet won't crease (this means if it gets crumpled, it won't be ruined), it can be torn straight or random pieces, it stores in a convenient box with a handy tear edge. Each box contains a strip 12 inches wide by 15 feet long, so there is plenty for any project.

To use the tissue as a base, adhere it directly onto a surface with decoupage. My favorite is Deco Art's DecouPage Matte. Following manufacturer's directions, simply apply a layer on the surface, place tissue, smooth to remove any wrinkles or bubbles and immediately apply a topcoat over tissue to seal. To use an accent, cut or tear pieces to decoupage onto the project. These pieces can be used as borders, accents or highlights. Glazing can be added to tone down or mute the design to coordinate and bring it together. Add shading around the edges for a cohesive look. Stencil over top with paint or texture for interest. The border design in the photo was created using Media Modeling Paste and Gothic Layering Stencil. The possibilities are endless.
